OUR PURPOSE

- Leadership Person County is a leadership development program sponsored by the Roxboro Area Chamber of Commerce. The program is designed to enhance leadership skills for current and future leaders. Persons completing the program are encouraged to volunteer their time and talents for the betterment of the community.
- Provide insight as to how Person County functions as a community politically, socially, economically and culturally.
- Motivate and further prepare participants for leadership within the community.
- Develop a working relationship among participants and community leaders.
- Familiarize participants with Person County as a whole, exposing them to people and aspects of the community they would normally not encounter.



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OUR GOAL

- To enhance leadership skills for each participant so they may be better leaders in the workplace and in the community.
- For participants to have a greater understanding of Person County, its makeup and functions, so they can be a part of its continued development and evolution.

Person County has a continuing need for effective community leaders who will work to provide a high quality of life for its citizens.

Those who are called upon to fill community leadership positions need basic skills applicable to today's environment and knowledge of the community's assets.

Such an important matter as community leadership should not be left to chance. Existing and potential leaders should be sought out and given an opportunity to learn more about the area.

OUR OBJECTIVES

- Identify/select highly motivated individuals who will benefit from the program and in turn be a valuable asset as a community leader.
- Examine needs in the community and challenge participants to respond.
- Identify organizational and individual opportunities for community involvement.
- Create a dialogue and sense of teamwork between the participants and existing community leadership.
- Assist participants in building & expanding their network of community contacts.

REGISTRATION

- The registration fee for the program is \$200, which covers course materials, full-day excursion lunches & expenses, plus attendance for one to RACC's Annual Banquet.
- Companies and organizations are urged to sponsor individuals who have demonstrated potential as leaders and will benefit from learning more about Person County, regardless of how long they have lived/worked in the area.
- The ideal class number is no more than 30. It is important for participants to register early and secure their spot!
